If you were going 25 mph or more over the speed limit, you are not eligible.

You must have a valid driver's license that is not a commercial license. If you have had a ticket deferred in the last 12 months you are not eligible. If you are under the age of 25 you MUST take a defensive driving course as a condition of deferred disposition. To apply for deferred disposition you must have your request postmarked on or before your court date:

- This request form, signed by defendant
- A copy of your Driver's License.
- A self addressed, stamped envelope
- A cashier's check or money order (made payable to the City of Ferris) for your fine amount PLUS an additional \$50.00 administrative fee (NO PERSONAL CHECKS OR CASH). Please contact the Court Clerk at (972) 842-2028 for fine amount.
